All patients will spend some time in the post-op recovery room following surgery. The exact amount of time can vary depending on the length of anesthesia and sensitivity of the patient to medication, but usually is not greater than 2 hours. Once you are stable enough to leave recovery room, you will typically be discharged home directly from the recovery room. <b>Under no circumstances are patients allowed to drive themselves home after the procedure.</b>
